The future stars of women's golf are returning to the birthplace of the LPGA for the second year in a row. The 2022 event was such a huge success, the WAPT has asked Rolling Hills to host the Championship Tournament in August 2023.

What makes this tour so special is the ability to bring Women's Professional Golf back to the birthplace of the LPGA and doing so in the Club's 75th year is even more remarkable. Rolling Hills Country Club opened in 1948 when 84 families purchased the site from the Westlink Golf Course. Soon after, Rolling Hills' own rich history became a foundation for women's golf. Many top female players of the day competed in the 1950 Women's U.S. Open hosted by RHCC. The LPGA was founded by 13 legendary players during this tournament, in the very clubhouse members use today.
